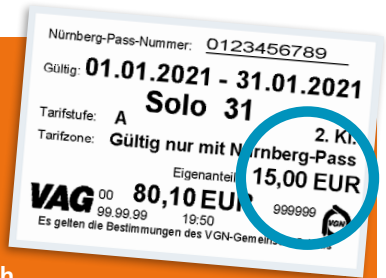
What costs less with the Nuremberg Pass?

Lots of things cost less with the Nuremberg Pass. For example:

- Learning a foreign language
- Going to the zoo
- Joining a sports club
- Attending a lunch for senior citizens
- Going to a museum
- Travelling by bus and train in Nuremberg and Fürth

The Solo 31 ticket is valid for buses and trains (zones 100+200, tariff zone A in Nuremberg and Fürth). The ticket is valid for one traveller. This person needs a valid Nuremberg Pass, which must be shown upon request. Your personal identity card must also be shown during a check. You can buy your ticket at any VAG ticket machine in your vicinity or at the VAG customer centre at the main station.

Who is entitled to the Nuremberg Pass?

The Nuremberg Pass is available to children, adults and senior citizens from Nuremberg. You must live in Nuremberg and be in receipt of welfare payments. Your welfare payments may be from the following offices:

- The Job Centre (unemployment benefit II, ...)
- The Social Welfare Office (basic income support, assistance with living costs, housing benefit, benefits for asylum seekers)
- The Family Benefits Office (child supplement)
- The Youth Welfare Office (subsidy for kindergarten fees, ...)
- The District of Middle Franconia (basic income support, assistance with living costs, cash allowance)



How do I apply for the Nuremberg Pass?

Please let us know in writing who you are, where you live and that you would like to apply for the Nuremberg Pass. You will need a copy of your identity card or passport and the notice from one of the offices referred to above.

Write to us using the online contact form on the website of Nuremberg Social Welfare Office (www.nuernberg-pass.nuernberg.de) and upload the copies as PDF files here.

These options are also available:

- Send us your application by post.
- Drop your application off at our mailbox.
